



Camp Spirit Youth Crew

PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF THE WORK

The Youth Crew works directly with the children of Camp Spirit. The Crew member will commit to full participation in week long staff training, and a minimum of two weeks of leadership during Camp Spirit. Youth Crew bring a positive attitude, a love of children, a growing faith and a willingness to work in a team. Successful candidates will be in grade 9 or older at the time of Application.

Youth Crew duties will include:

Leadership and Support of the Camp Spirit Program:

- Shared leadership of program plan for the age group to which the crew member is assigned for the week (9 am – 3 pm)
- Team work with small leadership team (Coordinator, 1 – 2 Leadership Crew, 1 LiT)
- Provide hands on leadership in a variety of ways including but not limited to:
 - Sharing bible stories using Godly Play and other media
 - Creating Visual art activities and sharing them with children
 - Exploring Science with children
 - Leading games in various settings (both as community builders or energizers)
 - Singing, creating dramas
- Support and care for children with love and respect
- Gather and prepare resources and materials for each day's program experience
- Participate in the leadership of opening and closing worship gatherings
- Support the work of volunteers in a respectful and appreciative way
- Participation in set up, staff debrief and feedback, and room and supply clean up each day

The Camp Spirit Youth Crew will receive support from staff and site volunteers in their experience of Camp Spirit. The youth crew will experience:

- leading children
- collaborative team leadership
- a faith based environment
- Deepening of leadership skills
- Camp Spirit mission and values

Compensation

This is a volunteer leadership learning position with a small gift of \$300 per week for each week worked in appreciation. Camp crew is on site from 8:30 am - 3:30 pm with breaks. All snacks and lunches are provided. Each crew member will receive a T-shirt.
